

We Are at War!

God has defeated Satan once and for all at the cross. As seen in the life of Job, Satan's war with God finds its battleground in the lives and hearts of men. He fights God by snatching souls away from the cross through temptation and sin.

Motivated by love, God created us with the choice to respond to His love with our own love. Do we understand that this choice is the battleground? C. S. Lewis said, "Our leisure, even our play, is a matter of serious concern. There is no neutral ground in the universe: every square inch, every split second, is claimed by God and counterclaimed by Satan." Paul said, "See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil. Therefore, do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is" (Eph. 5:15-17). Again, he said, "Walk in wisdom toward those who are outside, redeeming the time. Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one" (Col. 4:5-6).

You do not know how much time you have. But with the time God has given you, you can redeem the physical elements that would otherwise be left to the purposes of Satan. Are you engaging the people in your circle in ways that make them consider their eternity? Is your leisure time kingdom-focused or self-focused? Do you tend to talk about people behind their back, or do you encourage and pray for them? Are you more likely to get even or show meekness and humility? In the spiritual battlefields of life, Satan will be claiming victories if you are not redeeming the time for the work of the Lord. How many victories does Satan have in your life?
